The Wright County Parks and Recreation Department would like to inform you that there is one (1) seasonal campsite available at Schroeder Park and Campground for the 2018 Camping Season. If you are interested in the available seasonal site please fill out a Seasonal Campsite Lottery Request form that has been provided for you. You may also find it online at <http://www.co.wright.mn.us/parks>. The Lottery Request form must be submitted to the Wright County Parks and Recreation Department no later than 4:30 p.m. on Friday, February 16, 2018. We will have a blind lottery draw on Wednesday, February 21, 2018 at 10 a.m. at the Parks and Recreation Department main office in Buffalo, MN to determine who will receive the available site. To recap:

1. One (1) seasonal sites (#28) is available at Schroeder Park and Campground
2. Lottery Request form must be returned to the Parks and Recreation Department by 4:30 p.m. on Friday, February 16, 2018.
3. A blind lottery draw will take place on Wednesday, February 21, 2018 at 10 a.m. at the Parks and Recreation Department main office in Buffalo to determine who will receive the available site.

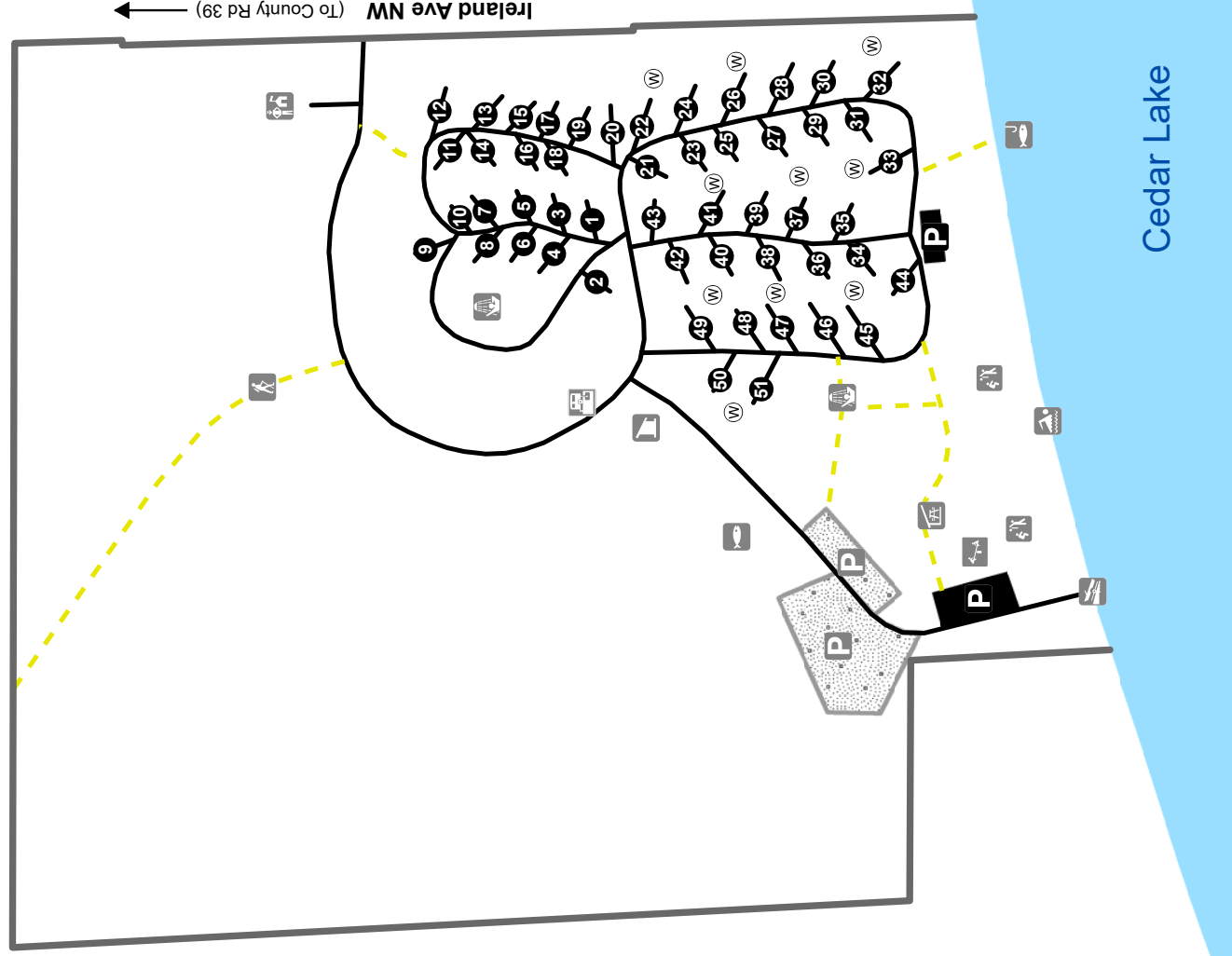
INFORMATION ON SEASONAL SITES

- X Deadline for submitting the lottery application is Friday, February 16, 2018. A lottery drawing for the one seasonal campsite will be held on Wednesday, February 21, 2018 at 10 a.m.
- X Cost for the 2018 Season is \$1900, includes electric.
- X If you are selected payment for half of the cost (\$950) must be paid within one week from notification. You will be notified by email if you are not selected for a seasonal site through the lottery. If you are selected through the lottery you will be notified via a phone call from the Parks and Recreation Department.
- X If selected, the second-half payment (\$950) must be submitted prior to May 19, 2018 at the Park Office.
- X Seasonal sites may be occupied only by the person(s) listed as permit holders or their immediate family. Subletting of seasonal sites by the permit holder is not allowed.
- X The last day of overnight camping for the 2018 season is October 6, 2018. No overnight camping will be allowed after that date. All campers and belongings must be removed by October 7, 2018.
- X Tentative dates for the 2018 season are Friday, May 4, 2018 thru Sunday, October 7, 2018.

Welcome

Schroeder Park is located on the shores of beautiful Cedar Lake in Wright County, Minnesota, two miles northeast of Annandale, off CSAH 39. As campers, you are sure to enjoy the recreational opportunities that exist within the park. It offers a spacious sand beach for swimming and water front activities, along with boat access, fishing pier, horseshoes, sand volleyball, a small hiking trail, picnic area and shelter, and a large playground.

The campground offers 50 overnight camping sites with electric hookups and showers onsite. There is a sanitary disposal station located in the campground and a small camp store. The camp store offers snacks as well as information on area recreational opportunities.

Rules

1. All Park Ordinances shall apply to campers and visitors.
2. Campers 17 years of age or under must be accompanied by a parent or guardian.
3. One camping unit per site. (Exception: one small tent allowed for children 17 years of age or under.)
4. Prior approval from the campground office must be obtained before changing sites.
5. Campers must register by 11:00 a.m. If they wish to stay an additional night, providing that a site is available.
6. Campground manager reserves the right to ask any user to leave the park upon violation of park rules.
7. It is requested that bike riding be limited to daylight hours.
8. Alcoholic beverages are prohibited.
9. Disturbing wildlife, cutting plant material, gathering firewood, defacing property, discharging waste water (except in designated areas), and all-terrain vehicles are prohibited.
10. Pets are welcome and should be kept on a six-foot leash and all droppings picked up. Pets are not allowed in park buildings, on the beach, or in picnic areas.
11. A dumpster is provided within the park for your convenience. Please help us keep your park clean by disposing of garbage and refuse in the proper places.
12. The Wright County Parks Department is not responsible for any loss, damage, or injury sustained by a park visitor.
13. Campsites are furnished with one picnic table and one fire ring.
14. Two vehicles are allowed per site if space allows. Additional vehicles must park in the designated parking area.
15. The park is closed to non-campers from sunset to 6:00 a.m. These are also quiet hours.
16. Check-out time is 2:00 p.m.
17. Camping is limited to 14-day periods.
18. Swimming is allowed in designated areas only between the hours of 8:00 a.m. and sunset.
19. Firewood is available for sale at the camp store. Fires are to be kept in the fire rings provided.
20. No parking cars or campers on the grass. Boats and/or boat trailers are allowed on the grass at your campsite.

Reservations

- For reservations, call the campground office at (320) 274-8870.
- Weekend reservations must include Friday and Saturday nights. Holiday weekends must include a three-night stay. The reservation fee is \$5.00 (non-refundable). This fee, and camping fee for the entire length of stay must be paid at time of reservation.
- Reservations are accepted for a limited number of sites only. All other sites are rented on a first come, first served basis for drop-in campers.
- Notification of Cancellation four (4) or more days prior to arrival will be \$10 in addition to the \$5 non-refundable reservation fee. Less than four (4) will be charged the first night's camping fee and \$10 in addition to the \$5 non-refundable reservation fee.
- The site must be occupied by one camping unit each night. If the site is not occupied by 7:00 p.m., it may be rented to another customer without refund. If you are unable to arrive prior to 7:00 p.m., you must notify the park office in advance.
- Specific sites cannot be reserved. If you have special needs for handicapped accessible facilities, please request an accessible site. The park office will attempt to locate groups as close together as possible. Please understand it may not be possible to accommodate your request.
- Seasonal camping is allowed at six sites, filled by a lottery process. Seasonal campers are not allowed to have appliances or decks outside their camper. Carpets larger than 6 square feet located outside of a camping unit are not allowed.
