County State Aid Highway (CSAH) 37 Closure in Albertville due to Railroad Crossing Work, Oct. 11 – 13th

(Buffalo, MN) - The Wright County Highway Department would like to inform the public of a railroad crossing replacement on county highway 37 in Albertville that will require a highway closure on Wednesday, October 11th through Friday, October 13th, 2017. The project location is the BNSF Railway crossing on county highway 37, to the east of highway 19 and to the west of I-94 in Albertville, MN.

The work includes the removal of the existing railroad crossing and replacement with a new concrete railroad crossing. New bituminous pavement will be placed on each side of the crossing by Wright County maintenance staff.

The closing of county highway 37 will begin about 6:00 a.m. on Wednesday, October 11th, 2017 and is anticipated to last until the afternoon of Friday, October 13th. Please use alternate routes during this short term closure. Directional signing will be in place to direct traffic from the Outlet Mall back to I-94, as shown on the attached map.

The Wright County Highway Department asks your cooperation in this matter to ensure the safety of both the traveling public and construction workers. If you have any questions, please call 763-682-7383 between 8:00 a.m. and 4:30 p.m., Monday – Friday.
