## Project Background

Wright County, in partnership with the cities of Albertville and Otsego, is proposing to reconstruct portions of County Highway 37 from County Highway 18 to County Highway 19. The proposed improvements are intended to address safety and operational issues along the corridor and improve intersection safety and operations. The project is programmed for construction in 2019.

The proposed project will include the following:

- Potential intersection improvements to the Highway 37 and Highway 18 intersection
- Intersection improvements at the Highway 37 and Highway 19 intersection
- Expand County Highway 37 to three lanes east of Jansen Avenue
- Additional turn lanes
