

# Wright County Sheriff's Office Citizen Law Enforcement Academy



Thank you for your interest in the Wright County Sheriff's Office Citizen Law Enforcement Academy. This program is offered free of charge and will be held in the spring of 2016. Classes are two and a half hours long. The program will run for Five weeks. Instruction will be a combination of lecture, question and answer, demonstration, participation and tours. The classes and subjects will be very similar to those taught to new deputy sheriffs and police officers.

Participation in these classes will give students a unique insight into law enforcement, as the Wright County Sheriff's Office is one of the largest law enforcement agencies in the State of Minnesota and is charged with enforcing both criminal and civil law. This class is a benefit for business leaders, political leaders, teacher's, community leaders those who work with law enforcement or interested tax payers who want to know how law enforcement and the criminal justice system work from an insider's perspective. The Sheriff's Office is looking for a representative cross section of the community to participate in this unique educational experience. Applicants must be at least eighteen (18) years old. Due to the nature of the material presented, all applicants will be screened for criminal backgrounds.

Classes will be held from 6:30 to 9:00 P.M, **April 5th, 12th, 19th, 26th and May 3rd**. The classes will be held at the Wright County Law Enforcement Center at 3800 Braddock Ave NE, Buffalo, MN 55313.

A certificate of completion will be awarded at a commencement ceremony at the conclusion of the class (5th week).
