WHAT YOU NEED TO DO

The Minnesota Department of Health states elevated radon levels are likely to be found in two of five Minnesota homes. The first step toward “clearing the air” in your home is finding out if elevated levels of radon are present and, if so, your current level of exposure.

A short-term test kit is a good way to do this. These kits are available at home improvement centers and on the web. Wright County Public Health offers them directly to county residents at a discounted price of \$5.00. The price includes lab analysis and a report of the results.
