- Identify internal and external resources and strategize how to leverage these resources to promote resilience for all involved.

## PAYING FOR THE PARENTS FOREVER™, WRIGHT COUNTY PROGRAM

As mentioned, the registration fee for the entire course is \$89. You may qualify for a fee waiver or reduction.

- *Fee waiver* - If you have a court order for in forma pauperis (IFP), the fee for the class can be waived. Follow steps listed on the program website for receiving a fee waiver.
- *Fee reduction* -We do reduce the registration fee amount in some cases. To see the requirements and apply for a reduced fee, see the program website.
