We will establish eligibility through a quick intake process, and then work with our volunteers to set up a time to deliver items needed.

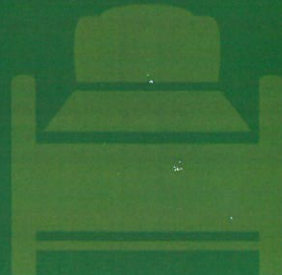
Client Stories
