The Wright County Parks and Recreation Department understands that there are events and activities that take place within County Owned Parks and Facilities where participants will find it desirable to include the responsible consumption of malt, wine, and cider beverages. To help better understand the limits which are in place in these parks and facilities, the following policy has been adopted:

The possession and consumption of alcoholic beverages in the Wright County Parks and Recreation System is limited to malt beverages, wine and cider products, at reserved facilities; these include:

Picnic shelters at:

- Beebe Lake County Park
- Clearwater/Pleasant County Park
- Otsego County Park
- Schroeder County Park
- Collinwood Regional Park
- Bertram Chain of Lakes Regional Park

Registered campers in their campsites:

- Collinwood Regional Park
- Schroeder County Park
- Bertram Chain of Lakes Regional Park

General Requirements:

1. Possession and consumption must follow State Laws including, but not limited to, no consumption by persons under the age of 21, and no consumption outside the limits of the reserved facility.
2. No alcoholic beverages can be present or consumed during organized youth activities.
3. No alcoholic beverages can be present or consumed at designated playgrounds or swimming beaches.
4. Glass containers are prohibited.
5. Kegs are prohibited.
6. The sale of alcoholic beverages is prohibited.
7. Alcohol beverages are not to be consumed, or served, as part of a public event unless co-hosted with the Wright County Parks Department and with permission from the Wright County Parks and Recreation Department.
8. The Wright County Parks and Recreation Commission may establish special restrictions and requirements.
