

**Collinwood Regional Park and Campground**  
(17251 - 70th St. SW, Cokato, MN)

This lakeside park offers a 69-unit campground with electrical hook ups and water available (40 sites), full service hook ups (15 sites), tent sites (10 sites), Group Camps (2 sites), non-electrical back in sites (2 sites), restrooms, and showers. Park features include group camp facilities, picnic area, reservable shelters, swimming beach, fishing pier, playground, hike/ski trails, water access, dump station, outdoor basketball court, and fish cleaning house. An on-site park manager is available mid-April through mid-October. For more information or to make reservations during this time, call 320-286-2801. For information during the off-season, call 763-682-7693 / 7894.



**Schroeder County Park and Campground**  
(9201 Ireland Ave. NW, Annandale, MN)

On Cedar Lake this park features a 51-unit campground with electrical hookups, showers, restrooms, attractive swimming beach, playground, short hiking trail, picnic grounds with a reservable shelter, sand volleyball courts, public water access, fishing pier, dump station, and fish cleaning house. An on-site park manager is available mid-April through mid-October. For more information or to make reservations during this time, call 320-274-8870. For information during the off-season, call 763-682-7693 / 7894.



**Bertram Chain of Lakes Regional Park**  
(1744 - 90th St. NE Monticello, MN)

Bertram Chain of Lakes is a 1253 acre Regional Park made possible through Parks and Trails Legacy Funds. Bertram offers users miles of hiking trails, cross-country ski trails, single track mountain bike trails, 4 lakes, a public beach and playground and plenty of space to explore the natural opportunities. At the South entrance to the park users will find the trail head for the single track trails, non-motorized access to Bertram Lake, and carry-in access to Long Lake for those that wish to paddle Long, Mud, and First Lakes. Through the North Entrance visitors to Bertram will find parking and access to a modern campground with 6 camper cabins and 38 RV sites with water and electric hook ups, public beach, playground, chalet (4-season rental facility), amphitheater and Y.M.C.A Camp Manitou facilities (usage for Y.M.C.A facilities requires a fee and available during the summer).



**Robert Ney Regional Park Reserve and Nature Center**  
(5212 - 73rd St. NW, Maple Lake, MN)

A combination of marsh, forest, and restoration areas occupy this 846-acre park, which provides a varied wildlife habitat. The park includes a memorial chapel, picnic area, DNR public water access to Lake Mary, 11 miles of trails for hike, ski, and equine use, a one-mile, self-guided interpretive trail, and is home to the Wright County Parks Environmental Education Center.



The Wright County Parks & Recreation Department maintains 33 facilities encompassing over 4,700 acres of open space and over 80 miles of trail for everyone to enjoy. As one of the premier park systems in the state of Minnesota, Wright County prides itself in conserving our natural resources for generations to come through excellence in our maintenance and standards within our parks. **Archery Range at Hasty/Silver Creek Sportsmen's Park**

**(10917 Duffield Ave. NW, Maple Lake, MN)**

A 10 target archery range that has targets ranging from 10-55 yards is located on the grounds of the Hasty-Silvercreek Sportsmen's Club. This is a cooperative project between the club and the Parks & Recreation Department.

**Carl Johnson County Park**

**(1200 Oliver Ave. NW, Cokato, MN)**

Wright County's *lost forty* has a one-mile hiking trail that leads visitors through a 40-acre parcel of mature hardwoods and interesting ravines.

**Clearwater County Wayside/Archery Range**

**(5201 - 130th St. NW, Clearwater, MN)**

This six-acre park with oaks and red cedars overlooks the Clearwater River and features a public archery range consisting of 15 targets.

**Crawford Lake County Park**

**(3700 Briarwood Ave. SE, Buffalo, MN)**

Features include a public water access, picnic area, and playground on the south shore of Crawford Lake.

**Dustin Monument County Wayside**

**(10474 US Highway 12, Howard Lake, MN)**

A historic site that includes two small picnic shelters and a seasonal restroom.

**Fairhaven Mill Historic County Park**

**(4999 Birchdale Rd, South Haven, MN)**

The site of a historic gristmill and a popular shore fishing destination, the park provides public water access to Lake Louisa, picnic area, and is an excellent spot to rest and relax.

**Marcus Zumbrunnen County Park**

**(One mile south of I-94 on County Road 8, Hasty, MN)**

A quiet little picnic spot that includes a relaxing one-mile hike and snowshoe trail.

**Beebe Lake County Park**

**(7250 - 10th St. NE, St. Michael, MN)**

Features include a swimming beach, reservable shelter, picnic area, 1.78 miles of trail, sand volleyball, modern restrooms, group camp, fishing pier, and playground. A caretaker is on duty May through September.



**Clearwater/Pleasant County Park**

**(10909 - 90th St. NW, Annandale, MN)**

Consisting of 210 acres between Clearwater and Pleasant Lakes. Features include a reservable shelter, swimming beach, paved trails, fishing pier, 18-hole disc golf with dual concrete tee pads, picnic area, public water access to Pleasant Lake, playground, modern restrooms, sand volleyball, off-leash pet area, and horseshoe pits. A caretaker is on duty May through September.



**Oscar and Anna Johnson County Park**

**(10999 Fetch Ave. SW, Waverly, MN)**

A popular spot on the shore of Dog Lake features a picnic area, swimming beach, public water access, and toilets.



**Riverside County Park**

**(12258 8th Street NE, Hanover, MN)**

A 17 acre park featuring a quarter mile of river frontage, river access, picnic area, canoe camping (by permit), a pit toilet, and an 8 target archery range.



**Stanley Eddy Regional Park Reserve**

**(17475 - 60th St. NW, South Haven, MN)**

Made up of three separate units, totaling 959 acres, with scenic rolling hills, lakes, and marshes. This park is a remnant of the Big Woods ecosystem and features miles of trails between the North and South Units for you to enjoy. A public water access to Moose Lake is located in the middle unit. Special permits are issued for carry-in camping. To obtain a permit, contact the Parks & Recreation Department office at 763-682-7693 / 7894 or visit us online to complete a special use permit.



**Montissippi Regional Park**

**(2801 Broadway W, Monticello, MN)**

A 170-acre park nestled along the Mississippi River with a two-miles of paved trail that meanders through coniferous and deciduous trees. The park includes a picnic area, canoe campsites, fishing pier, playground, sand volleyball, an 18-hole disc golf course with dual concrete tee pads, and a seasonal toilet. A permit must be obtained for camping at canoe sites.



**Harry Larson County Park**

**(12750 Clementa Ave. NW, Monticello, MN)**

A beautiful 176-acre park has a rolling terrain, forested with mature oak trees and pockets of big tooth aspen, and is dotted with wetlands. It offers users two miles of trails, carry-in access to North Lake, and a small picnic area.



**Otsego County Park**

**(15186 - 96th St. NW, Otsego, MN)**

Walk through a prairie or land your canoe at this 70-acre park on the Mississippi River, which features a picnic area with two reservable shelters, two miles of paved trails, open play field, playground, sand volleyball court, and seasonal restrooms. A caretaker is on duty May through September.



**Crow River Park System**

Wright County is known for its excellent system of parks along the North Fork and main branch of the Crow River. As a state-designated Canoe Route, it is one of the most scenic and accessible in the region.
